GUEST LECTURES

Prof. Raghunandan, SVS College, Bantwal addressed the students on the topic "Convergence of Priority and Profitability", on 24/07/2010.

He briefed about one of the most priority sectors which is highly beneficial with the amount of government subsidies, compared to profitability which has become urban oriented and considered antisocial as the major concern. 


