

Recognizing the need to understand the same, we at SDM thought of organizing a National Conference on the topic "Celebration of 150th Birth Anniversary of Swami Vivekananda" in association with Ramakrishna Mission, Mangalore so that we can deliberate on various issues relating to this area. This conference was planned accordingly by inviting eminent resource people and Academicians who are expert in this field.

The UGC sponsored National conference on "Celebration Of 150th Birth Anniversary Of Swami Vivekananda" was inaugurated by Swami Nikhileshwaranandaji, Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission, Vadodara on Friday, 11th July 2014 at 9.30 a.m. In his keynote address he highlighted the relevance of Swami Vivekananda's teaching to modern youth. In his keynote speech he talked about the evolution of the Internet and how Internet has played a key role in the revolution in the field of Big Data. He talked about the various technologies which are part of Big Data such as Map Reduce, Hadoop NOSQL databases etc. He also explained the uses and applications of Big Data. The chief guest, Mr. Divakar Kini, former Vice President, IT Architecture and Control, Emirates National Bank of Dubai, spoke about how Big Data has become useful for business and commerce. Planning and development of effective strategies has become easier for businesses and banks because of Big Data, he said. The guest of honour Mr. Venkatesh N Pandit, Senior QA Engineer, Operative Media, Bangalore & also Alumni of SDMCBM, spoke about how Big Data has revolutionized the uses of Internet and it has made us rethink our approaches to business, education, health and politics. 
