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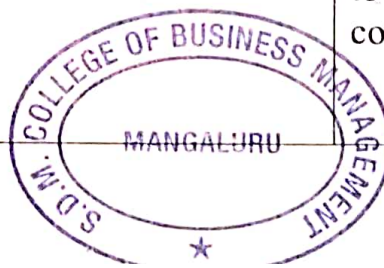






How do you rate the course you studied in terms of employability skills?
